The self-closing (mixer) taps are designed for application within the following limits of use:

- working pressure of maximum 1000 kPa;
- water temperature of maximum 90°C.

- working pressure of 100 kPa up to 500 kPa;
- water temperature of maximum 65°C

Marking

The Kiwa®-mark products are marked with the word mark “KIWA”.

Place of the mark:

- on the body.

- indication of the flow rate class, if classified: on the body;
