This permits the implementation of long MP-Bus lines (up to 800 m). Up to eight bus nodes can be connected in parallel and controlled and monitored by a master device (DDC with MP interface).

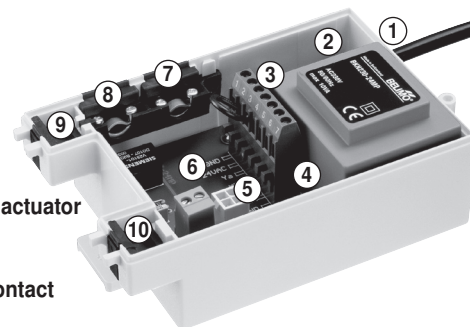

- Connections**
- ① Power supply: AC 230 V
 - ② Voltage indicator (LED green)
 - ③ Connecting terminals for local smoke detector contact
 - ④ Plug for BELIMO PC-Tool
 - ⑤ Plug for BELIMO Top-Line fire protection actuator
 - ⑥ Plug for MP-Bus network
 - ⑦ Cable feed-through for smoke detector contact
 - ⑧ Cable feed-through (e.g. for MP-Bus)
 - ⑨ Cable feed-through (e.g. BELIMO actuator)
 - ⑩ Cable feed-through (e.g. PC-Tool)

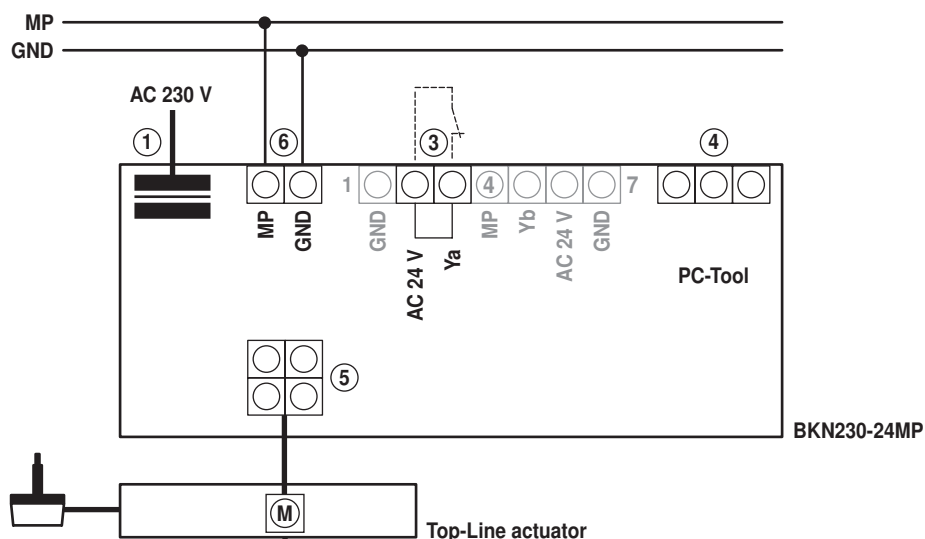


Please note!

- Pull out the AC 230V mains plug before opening the housing cover!
- Always connect the MP-Bus to plug 6, never directly to connection terminal 4!



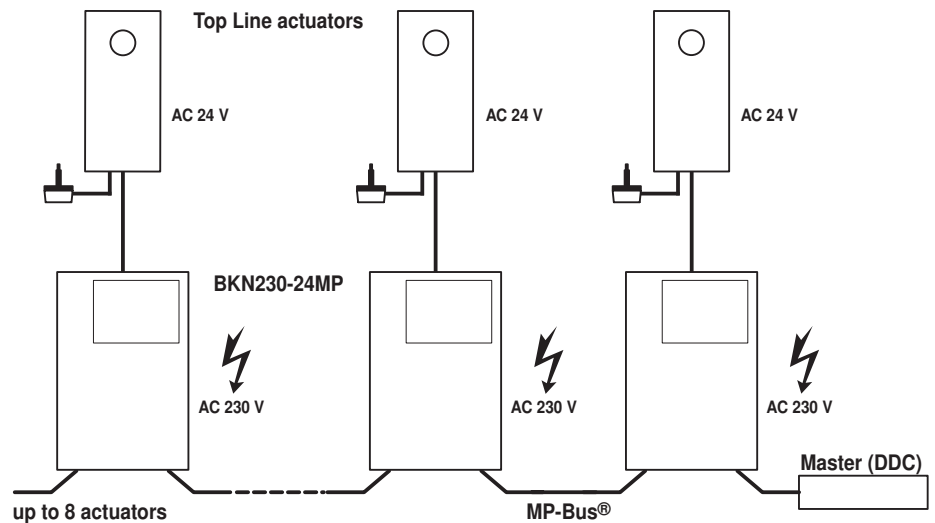
Wiring diagram

Topology

Each actuator is provided with voltage on-site. The communication line is therefore comprised of only two wires, for which no special requirements are specified, i.e. ferrule resistors or shielded conductors are not required.

The maximum permissible conductor length of the MP-Bus thereby is 800 m (0.75 m²).

Note

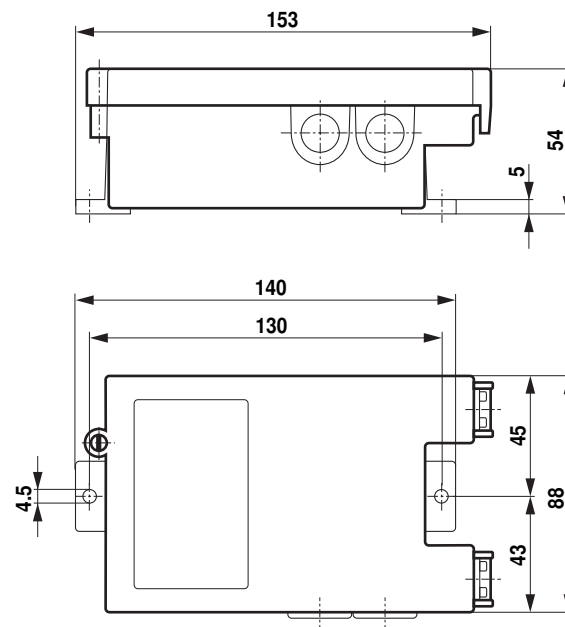
For safety reasons, BELIMO recommends that motorised fire protection dampers be operated only on separate networks.

Addressing

Addressing is accomplished by the Master, either semi-automatically by activating the hand crank on the actuator or manually via the ID number of the actuator. The address is thereby stored in the Top-Line actuator itself.

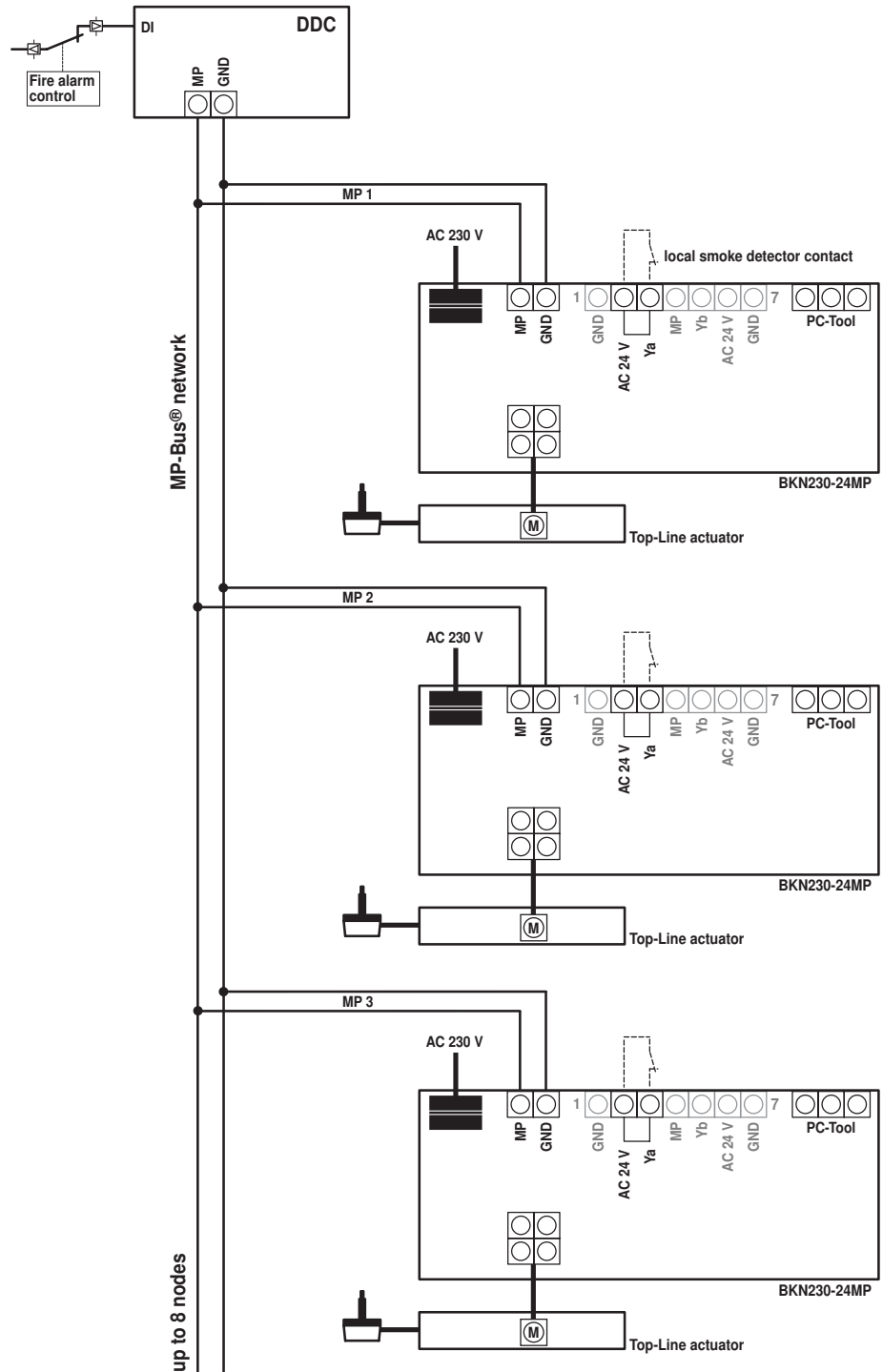

**Note**

External, local smoke detectors with potential-free normally closed (nc) contacts can be connected to the BKN230-24MP if required.

Features

Top-Line fire protection actuators are connected via BKN230-24MP and MP-Bus to one DDC controller with MP interface. The fire alarm control contact is read in by the DDC controller via a digital input.

Recommended application concept

If the emergency closing command arrives via the MP-Bus, then the status of the fire protection dampers can also be queried via MP-Bus after the emergency closing.

Addressing:

Addressing is accomplished by the Master, either semi-automatically by activating the hand crank on the actuator or manually via the ID number of the actuator. The address is thereby stored in the Top-Line actuator itself.
