This manual introduces P-Combiner-HV-3/6-V2 from Pylontech. P-Combiner-HV-3/6-V2 is the power combination box for ForceH series battery system. “-3” is for the type having 3 input terminals and 1 output terminal with 50A current. “-6” is for the type having 6 input terminals and 1 output terminal with 100A current. Please follow the instructions carefully during the installation process. Any confusion, please contact Pylontech for advice and clarification.

- 8) The warranty claims are excluded for direct or indirect damage due to items above.

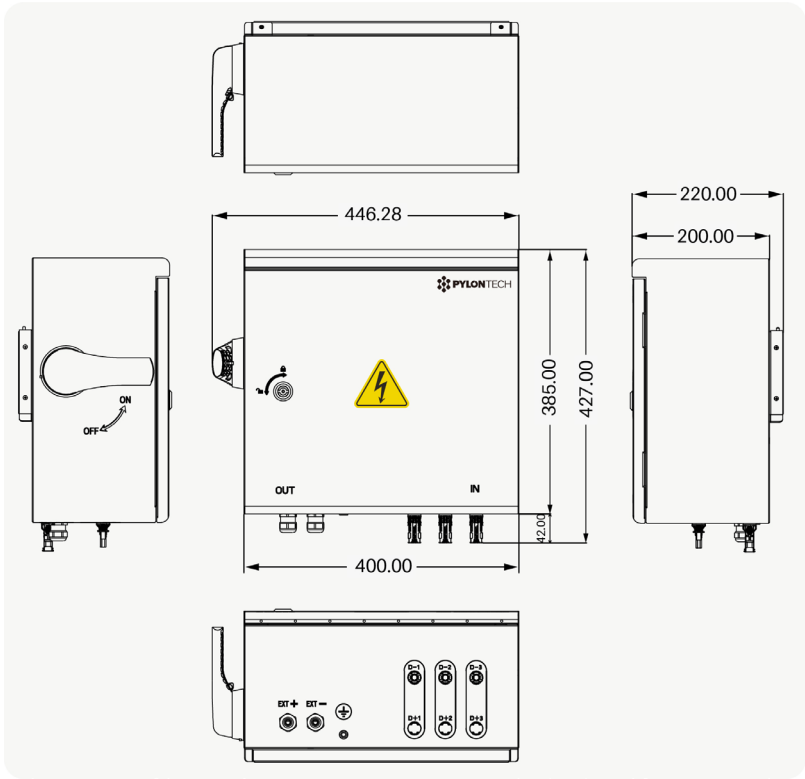
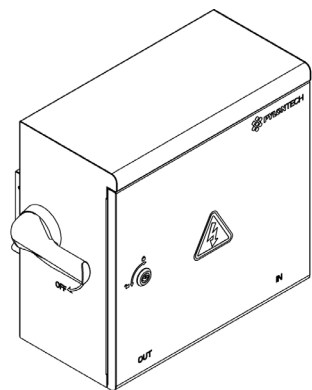
1.4 In Using

- 1) If any operation is required or fuse needs replacement, all the power source such as battery, inverter must be turned off and all the cables shall be completely disconnected.
- 2) DO NOT connect different types batteries in parallel through the P-Combiner box.
- 3) DO NOT connect inverter with voltage range higher than 1000V.
- 4) In case of fire, dry powder fire extinguisher or CO2 fire extinguisher is allowed. DO NOT use water before cutting all power off.
- 5) DO NOT open, repair or disassemble the battery except staffs from Pylontech or authorized by Pylontech. We do not undertake any consequences or related responsibility caused by violation of safety operation or violation of design, production and equipment safety standards.

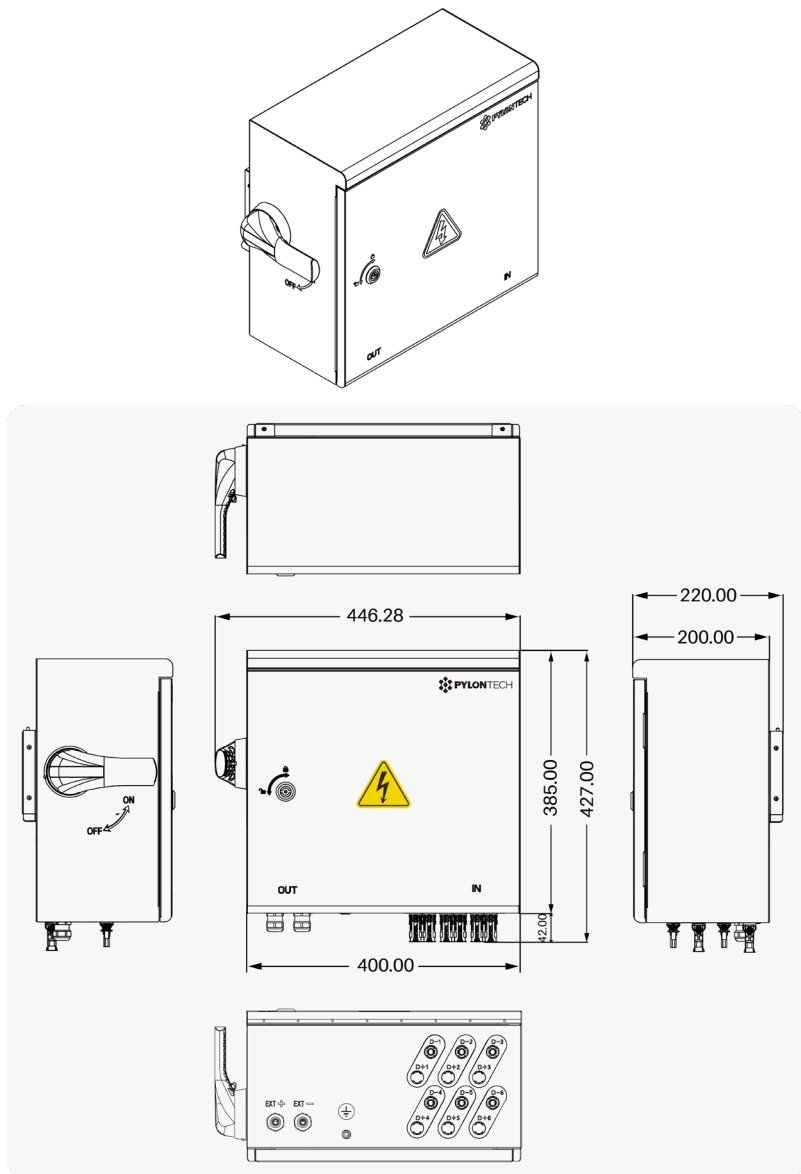

● B. P-Combiner-HV-6-V2

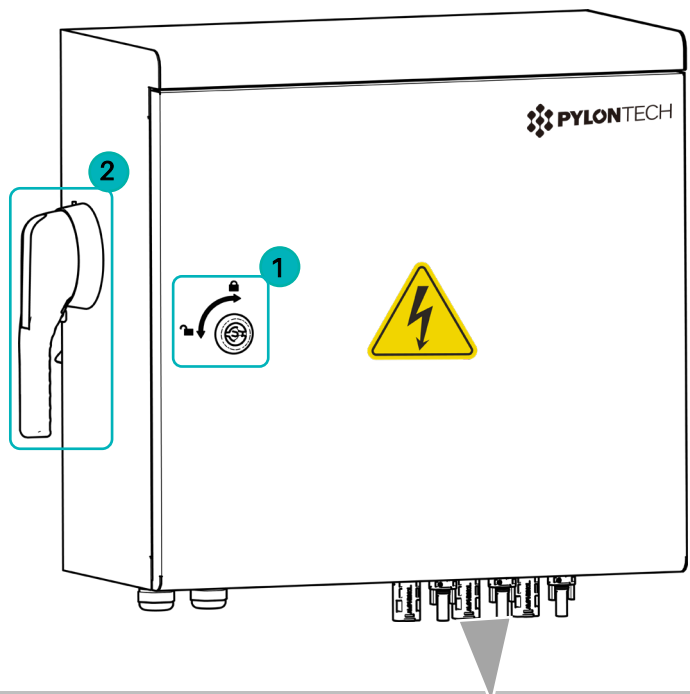

1) Box lock

Be sure to lock the box after installation.

2) Power switch

Switch to ON/OFF for main power loop.

3) Power terminal input

Connect to Force H Series battery power terminals.

4) Grounding point

Attach the grounding cable to the grounding point before connecting power cables.

The grounding resistance should be **smaller than 0.1Ω** .

5) Power terminal output

Connect to inverter.

P-Combiner-HV-3-V2, 6 AWG cable for maximum 50A current.

P-Combiner-HV-6-V2, 4AWG cable for maximum 100 A current.

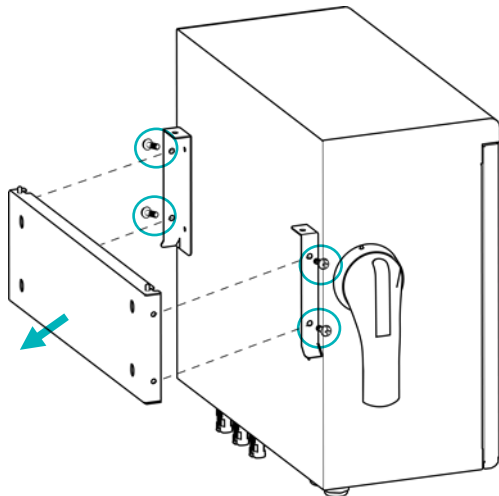
4.2 Wall Mounting Bracket Installation

(1) Unscrew to remove the wall mounting bracket from the combiner box.

Torque: 1.5-2.5 N.m

Tool: screw driver

Fastener: Screw, 4 pcs,
M4 x15

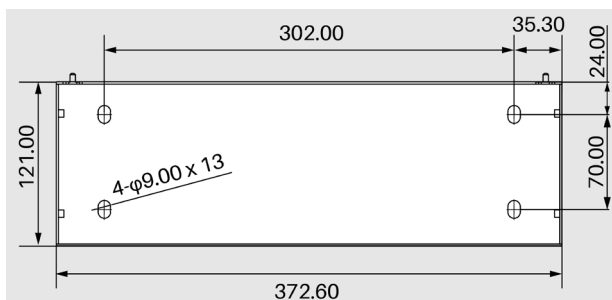


(2) Install the wall mounting bracket on the wall by fastening the 4 expansion bolts into the wall as shown.

Torque: 12-13 N.m

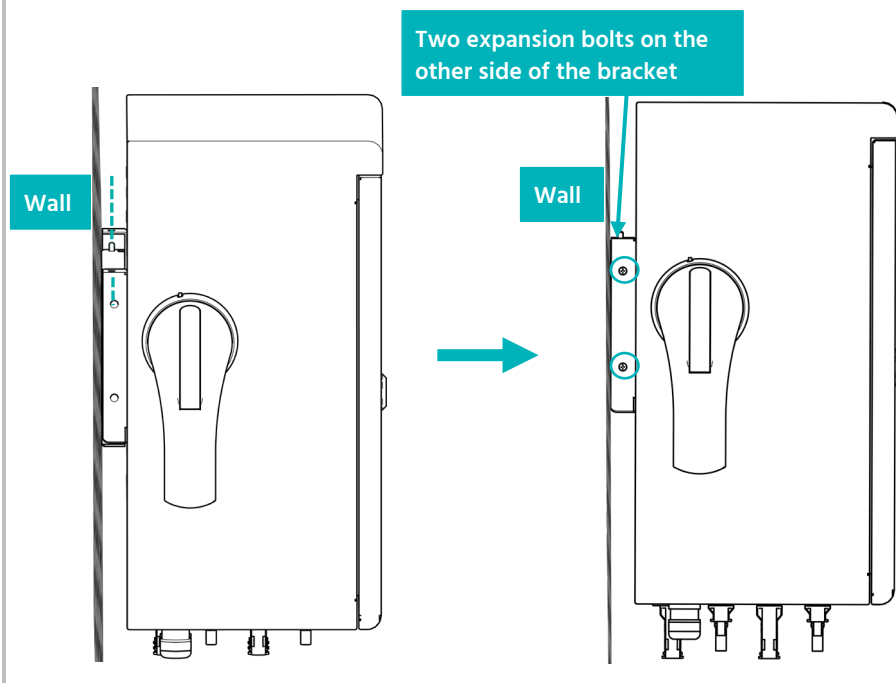
Tool: Socket Wrench

Fastener: expansion bolt, 4 pcs, M8 x 60



(3) Aligning the two holes with the pins on the mounting bracket, hang the box onto the bracket. Fasten four screws to fix the box.

Torque: 3.4-4.4 N.m; Tool: screw driver; Fastener: Screws, 4 pcs, M5 x12



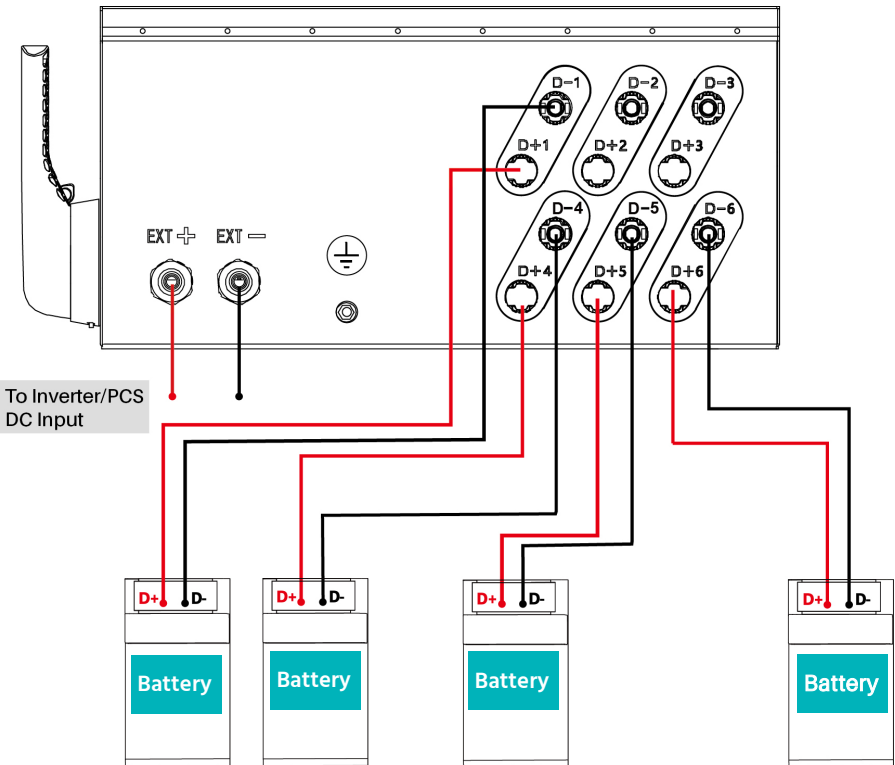
4.3 Cable Connection



Caution:

- 1) Ensure the switch is set to OFF.
- 2) Ensure NO reverse connection.
- 3) Ensure all cables connected in pair: 1+ and 1- from one battery.

- (1) Connect positive and negative power cables from battery to box.
- (2) Connect output power cables of the combiner box to the inverter or PCS.



NOTE: The above illustration of battery amount is for reference ONLY.

- For P-Combiner-HV-3-V2, there can be maximum 3 batteries connected to one combiner box.
- For P-Combiner-HV-6-V2, there can be maximum 6 batteries connected to one combiner box.

5. Remarks

For recycle and disposal, follow the local disposal rules.
