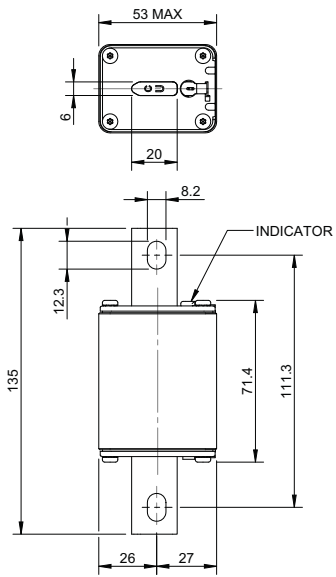

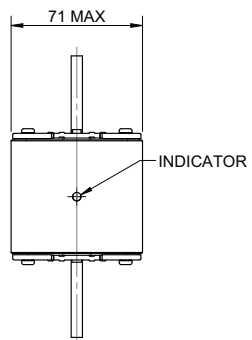

Temperature derating curve

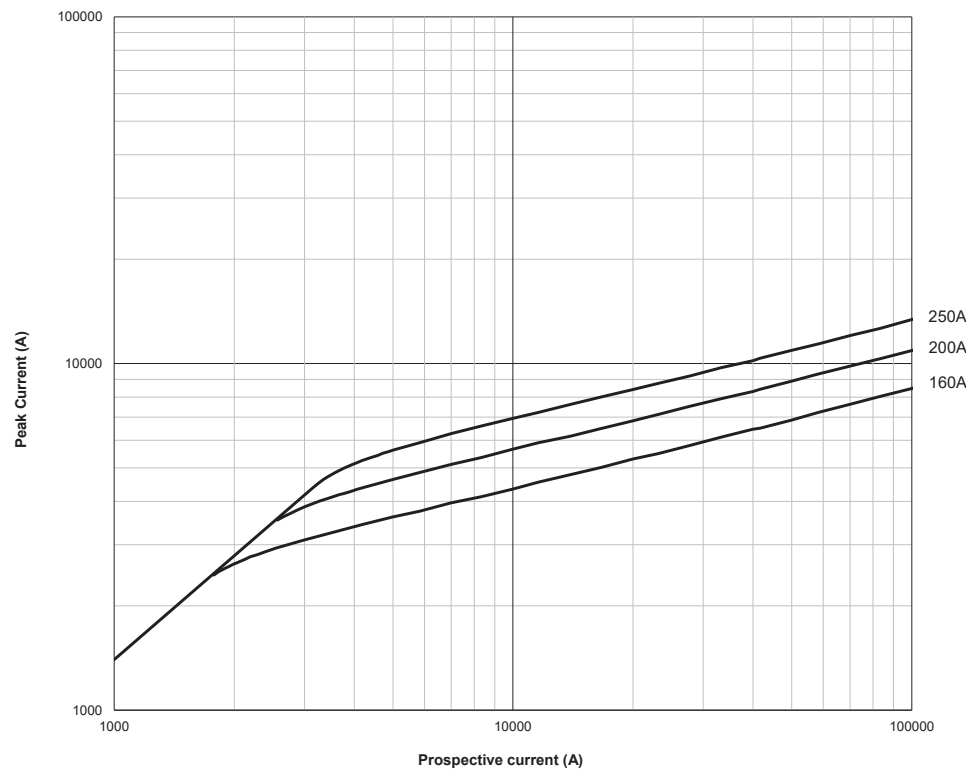


Cut-off peak current characteristic



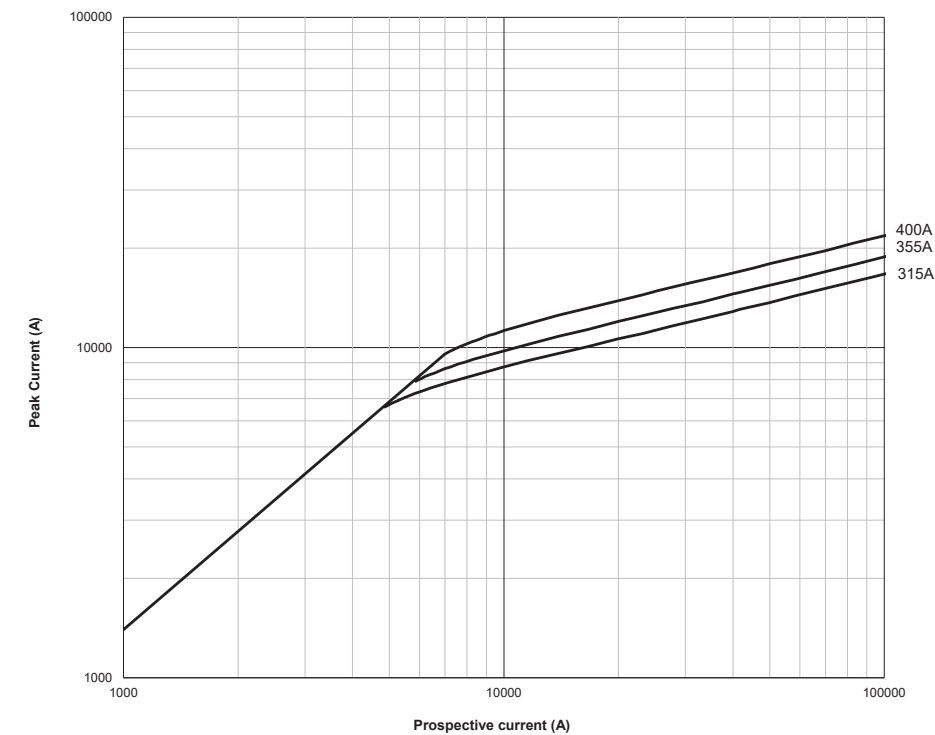

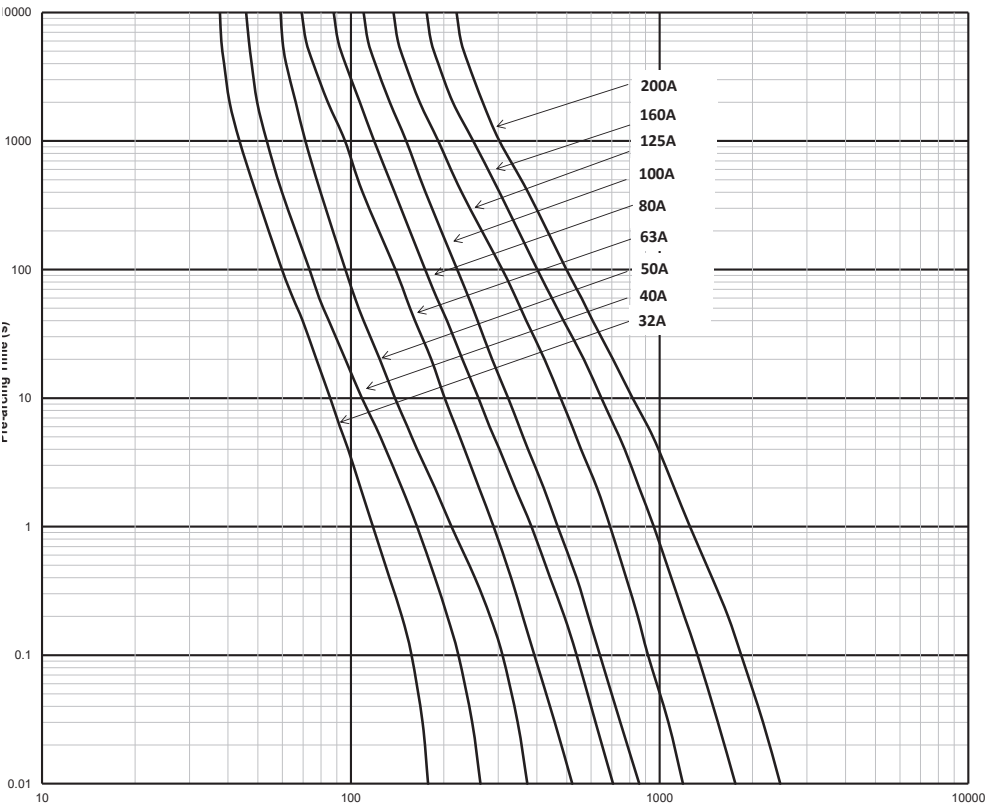
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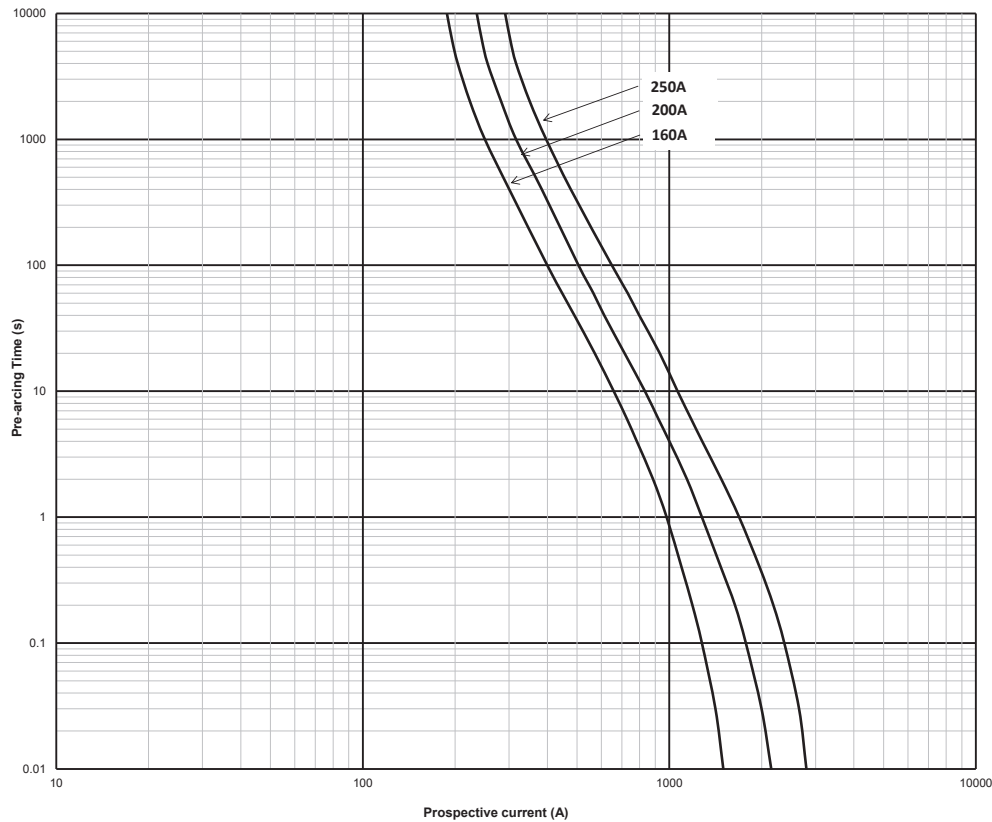

Time-current curve

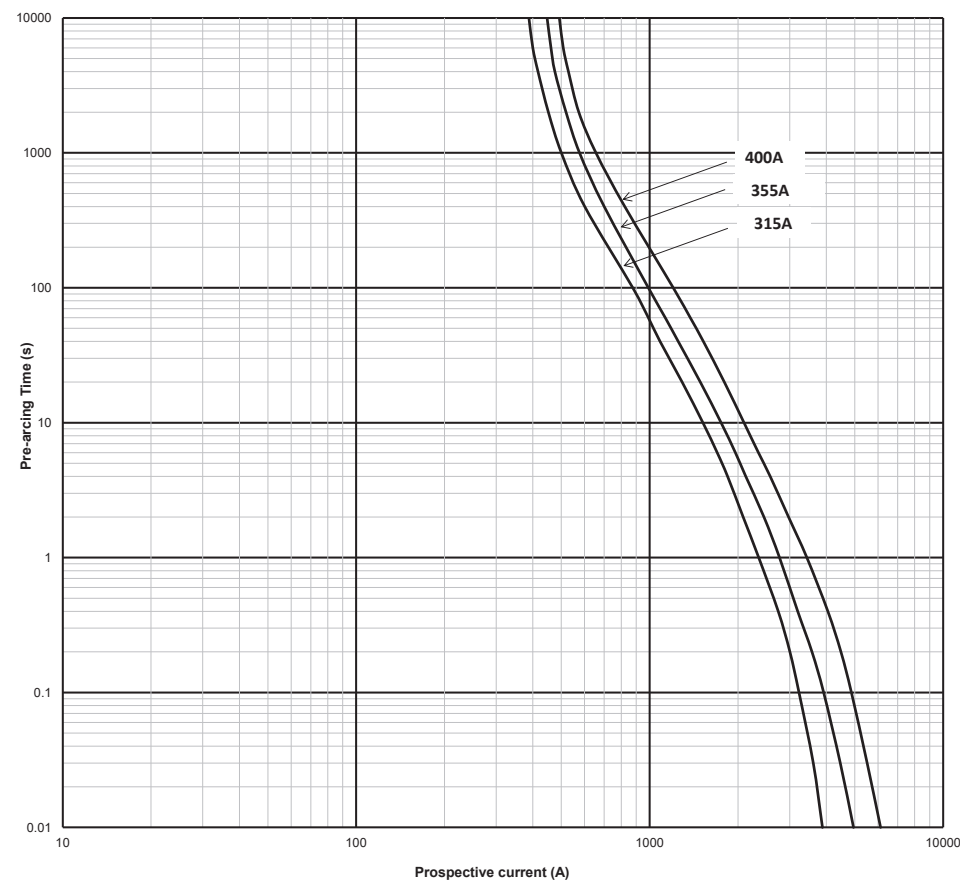

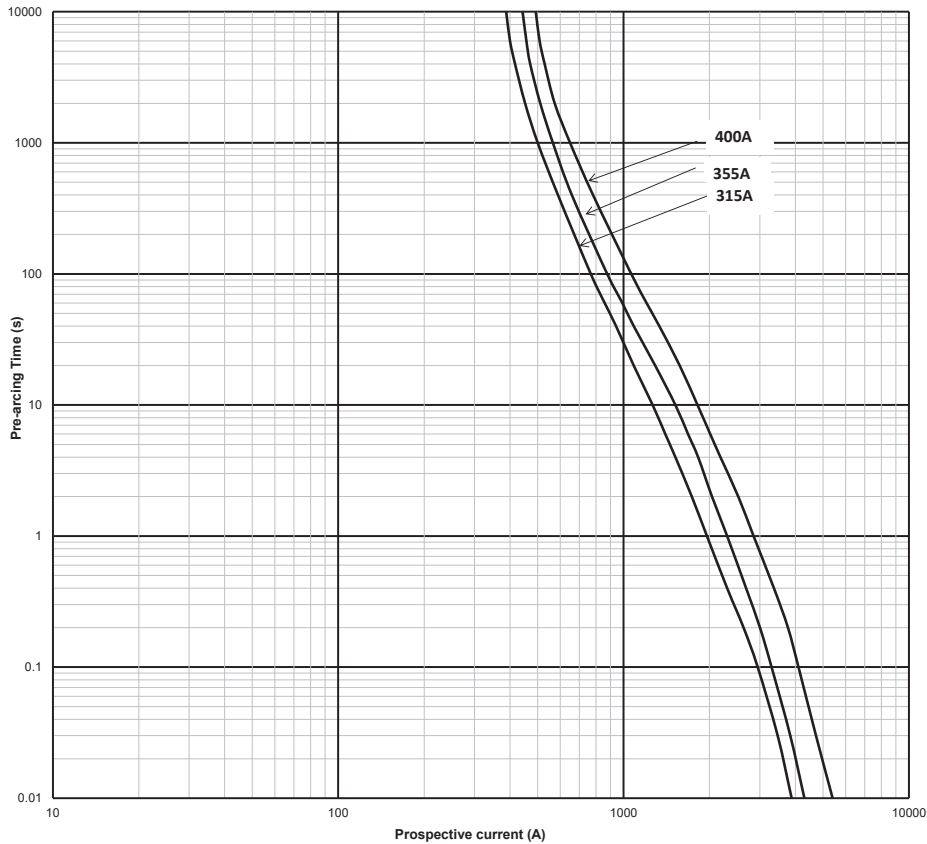
